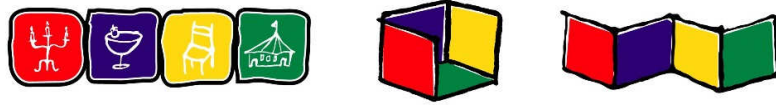

SITE SAFETY PLAN

Objective

The objective of this plan is to ensure the well being of all field personnel, plant staff and the community surrounding the site, and to provide relevant health and safety information to all parties involved in the project. Briefly, the information comprises:

- details of the work; an evaluation of hazards at the site;
- establishment of personnel protection standards and mandatory safety practices and procedures;
- assignment of responsibilities; and
- provision for contingencies that may arise while activities are being conducted at the site

All site personnel must follow the policies and procedures established in this Site Safety Plan. All personnel assigned to this project must sign the Agreement and Acknowledgement Sheet (Appendix A) to confirm that they understand and agree to abide by the provisions of this plan.

General Work Scope

The work to be conducted at the site by Renniks involves the erection of event structures at the site. The structures are pre-packed and all components are joined manually.

All components are secured to a metal plate, which are then connected to a portal frame to a vertical position. Once secured every fourth frame is cabled to the wall and the roof and PVC vinyl cladding is fixed from the ground via a sail mechanism. During the process of the erection of the event structures, no waste refuse is generated, no large machinery is used, no manufacturing is undertaken and no hazardous chemicals are used or stored on site.
