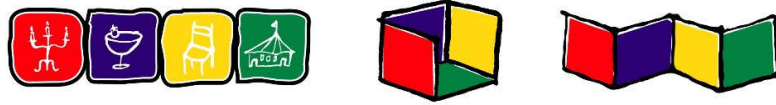

## ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

### Introduction

This Environmental Management Plan (EMP) is to provide The Renniks Group with a set of environmental safeguards that must be addressed to coincide with all current legislations and specifications applicable to the work being performed at the site. The Environmental Management Plan oversees all operations aspects of the erection of all structures and event marquees.

### Objectives

The objective of this plan is to give a management tool which will prevent or decrease any unfavorable environmental impacts as far as practicable.

### General Work Scope

The work to be conducted at the site by The Renniks Group involves the installation of event structures at the site. The structures are pre-packed and all components are joined manually.

All components are secured to a metal plate, which are then connected to a portal frame to a vertical position. Once secured every fourth frame is cabled to the wall and the roof and PVC vinyl cladding is fixed from the ground via a sail mechanism. During the process of the installation of the event structures, no waste refuse is generated, no large machinery is used, no manufacturing is undertaken and no hazardous chemicals are used or stored on site.
